What is SugoSure?

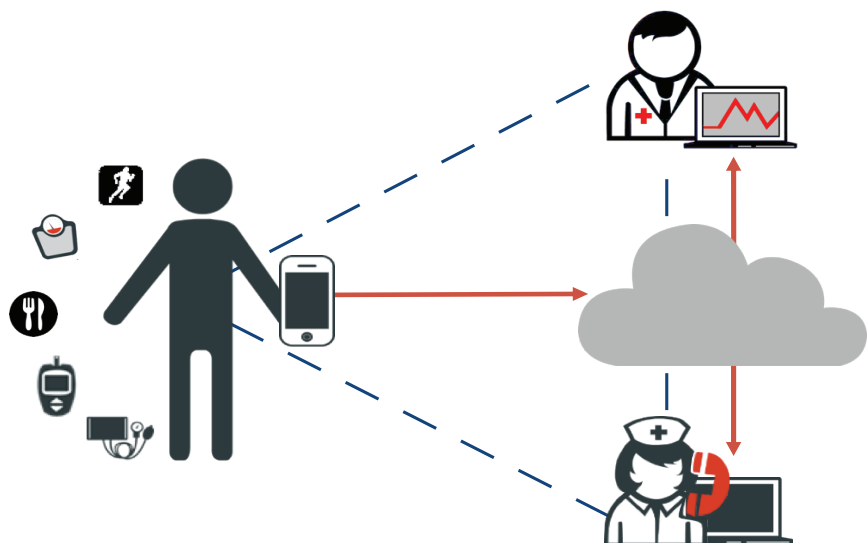
SugoSure is a disease management system which uses clinical data to transform care in Type 2 Diabetes Mellitus.

SugoSure gives you the support you need to better understand your condition and a structured approach to better dealing with its complexities. This will improve blood sugar control and significantly reduce the risk of longer-term complications.

The system is based on best-practice approaches to diabetes care, developed with leading experts and followed by your SugoSure doctor. It also includes comprehensive health coaching to help you deal with the many different things you need to think about.

SugoSure has three components: a portal for doctors, an app for patients and a health coaching service (including a chatbot). All three are linked and data is shared across the system, creating a circle of support around you.

Combined with integrated Health Coach support, SugoSure is a breakthrough approach to diabetes care



What is the patient panel?

We seek user input at every step of product design and development. SugoSure is now at an advanced stage of development and we seek feedback from patients on the near-to-complete product.

We are therefore building a panel of 10-15 'patient experts' whom we can periodically contact over the next 3 months as we finalise SugoSure's design.

Your involvement will entail:

Participation in a 1 ½ hour workshop in December where we will demonstrate the product and seek your views in a group setting
Using the app for 1 week in January and providing feedback on certain features

Answering 2-4 short email questionnaires

All patients on the panel will be paid the following for the involvement that they complete:

- 1 ½ hr workshop - \$50
- App trial - \$50
- Questionnaires - \$20 each

When SugoSure is launched in mid 2019, you will receive a 3 month free subscription
